

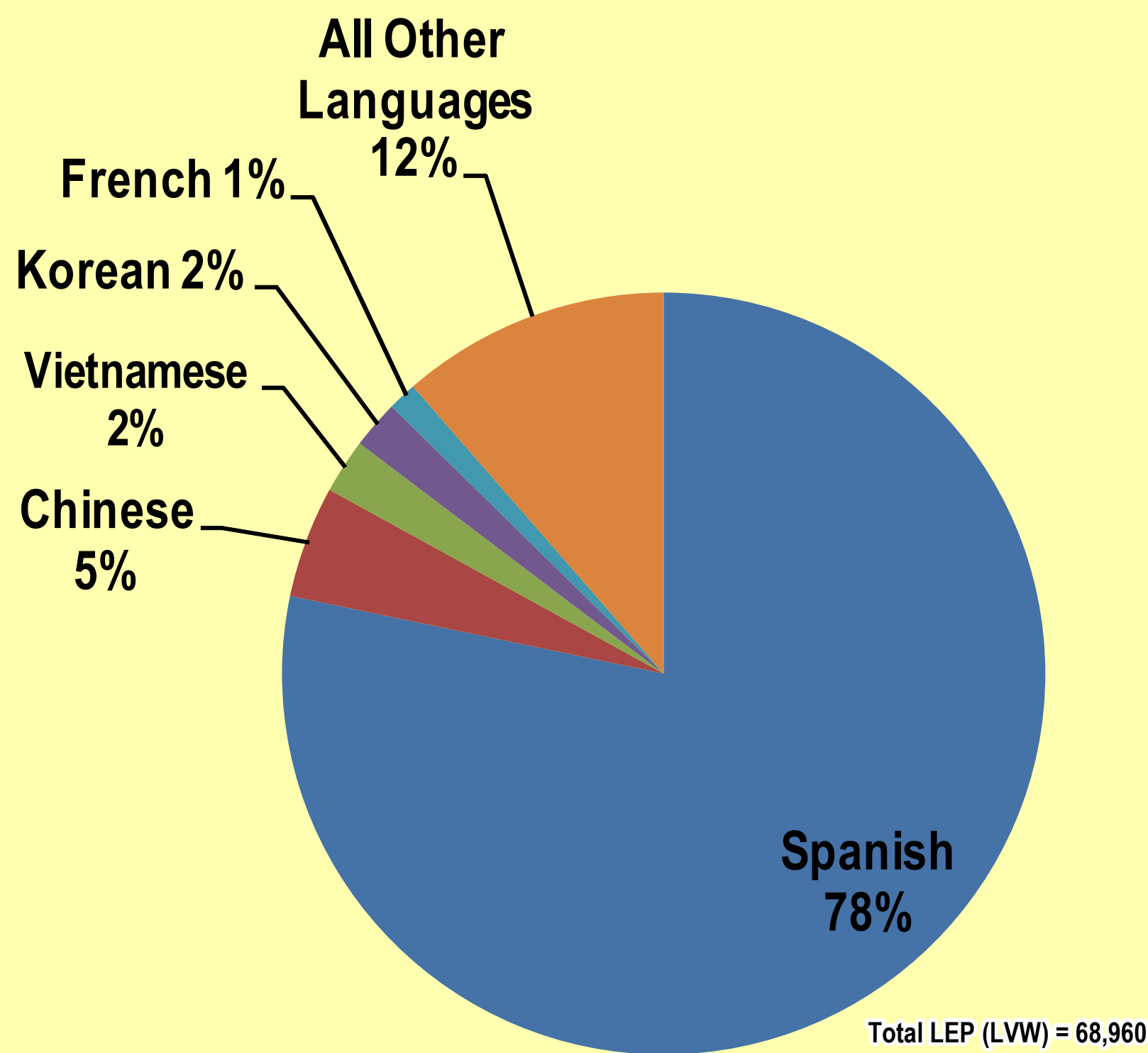
U.S. Judicial Districts - State of Alabama (2014)

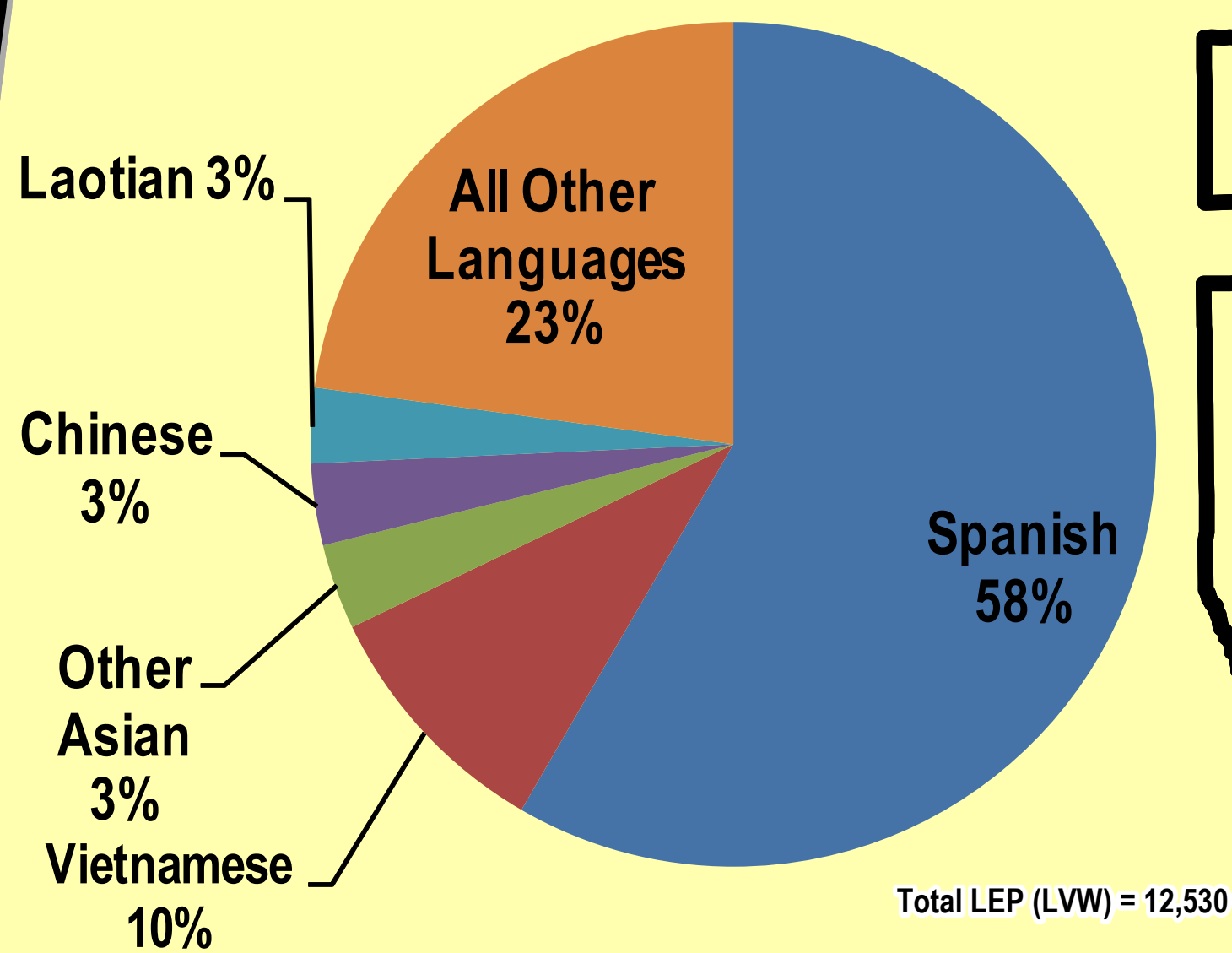

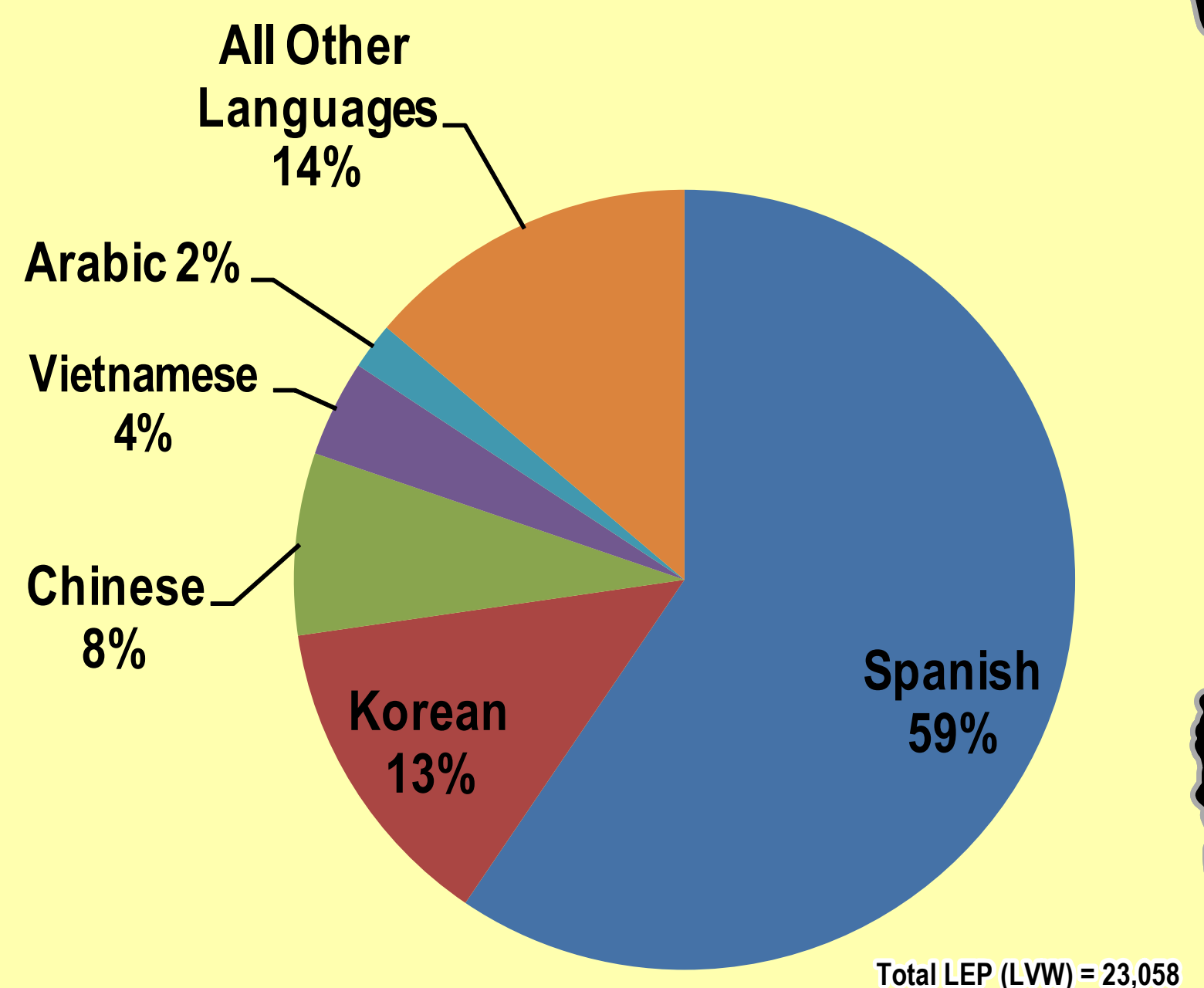

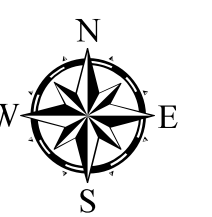
