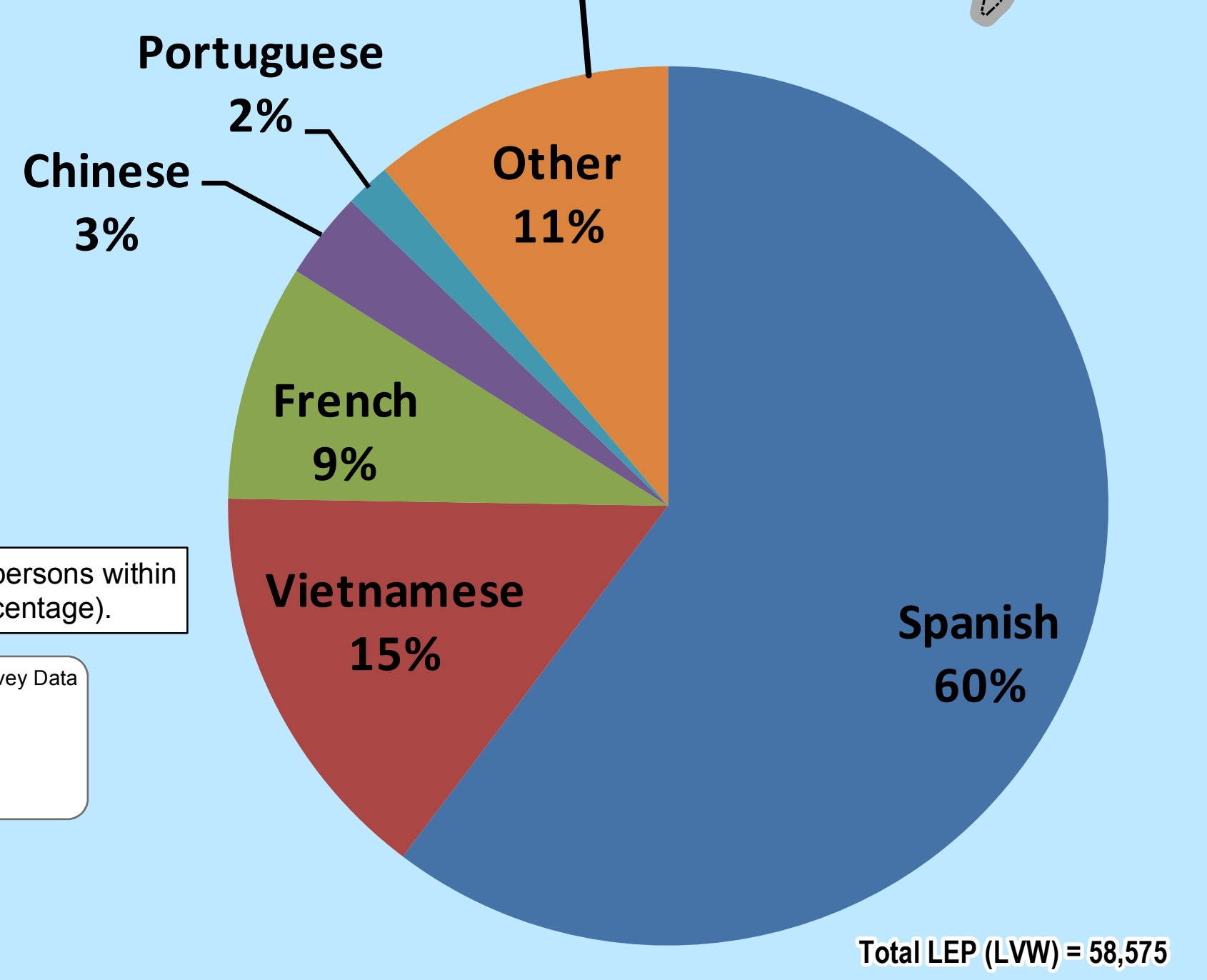
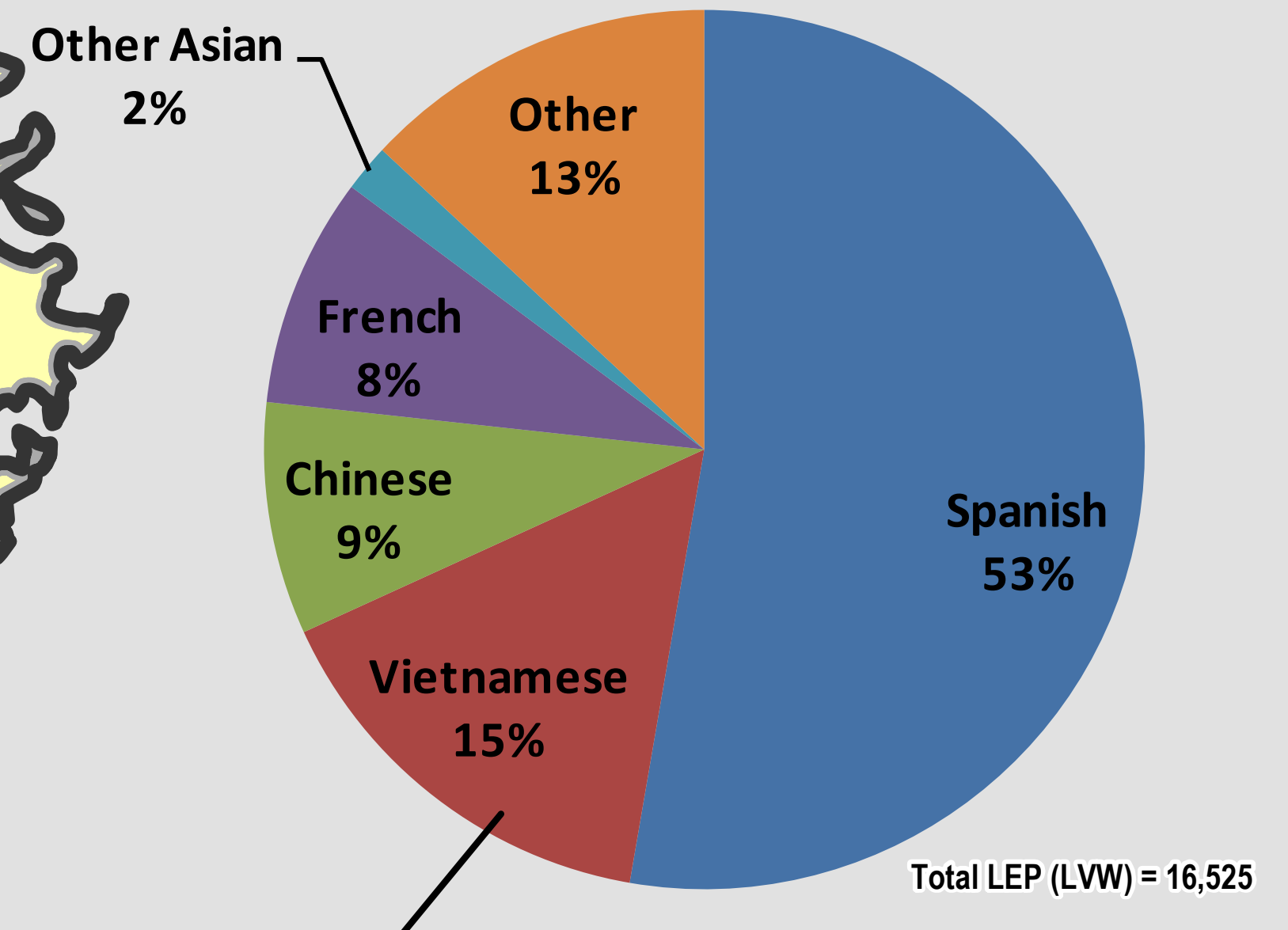
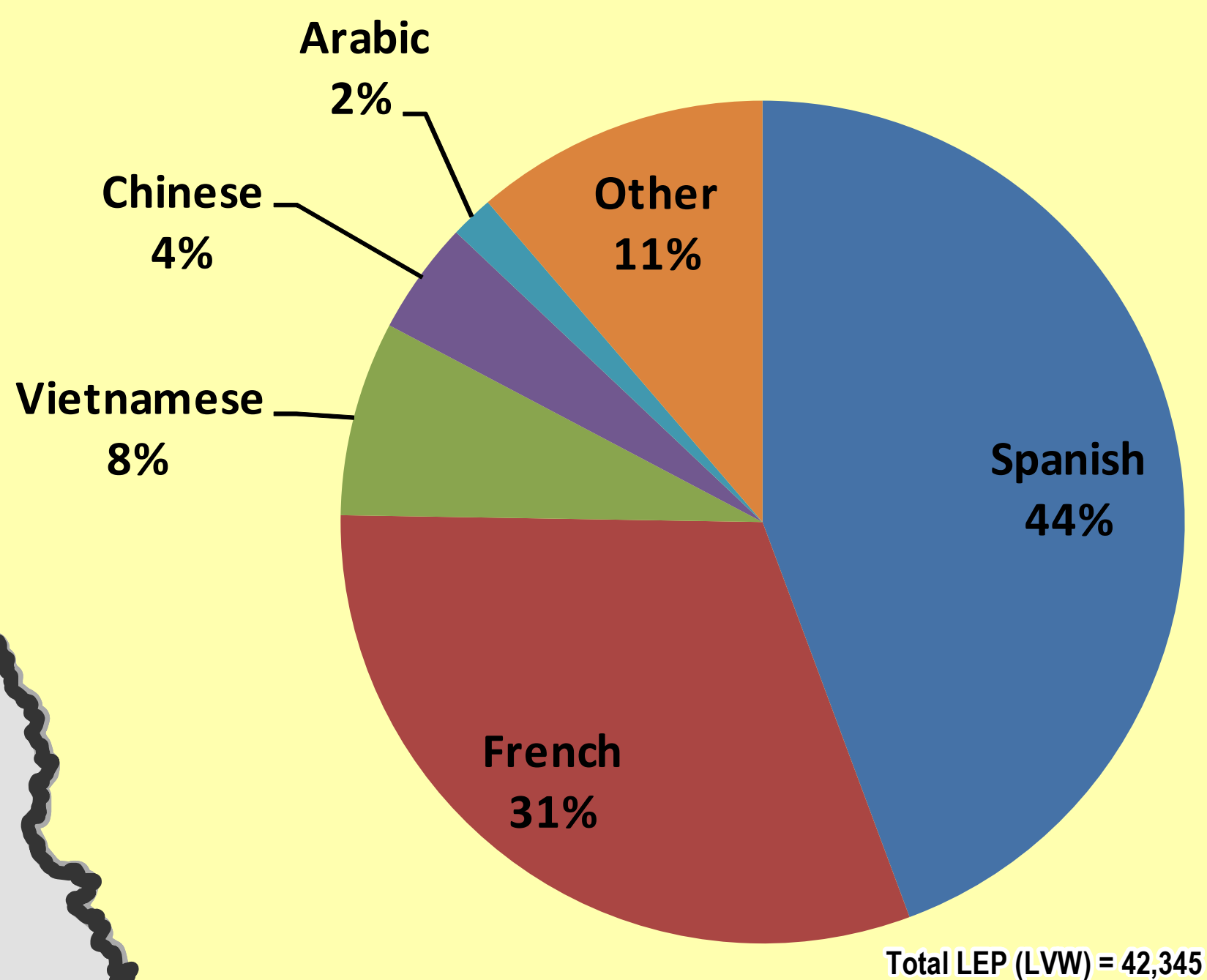
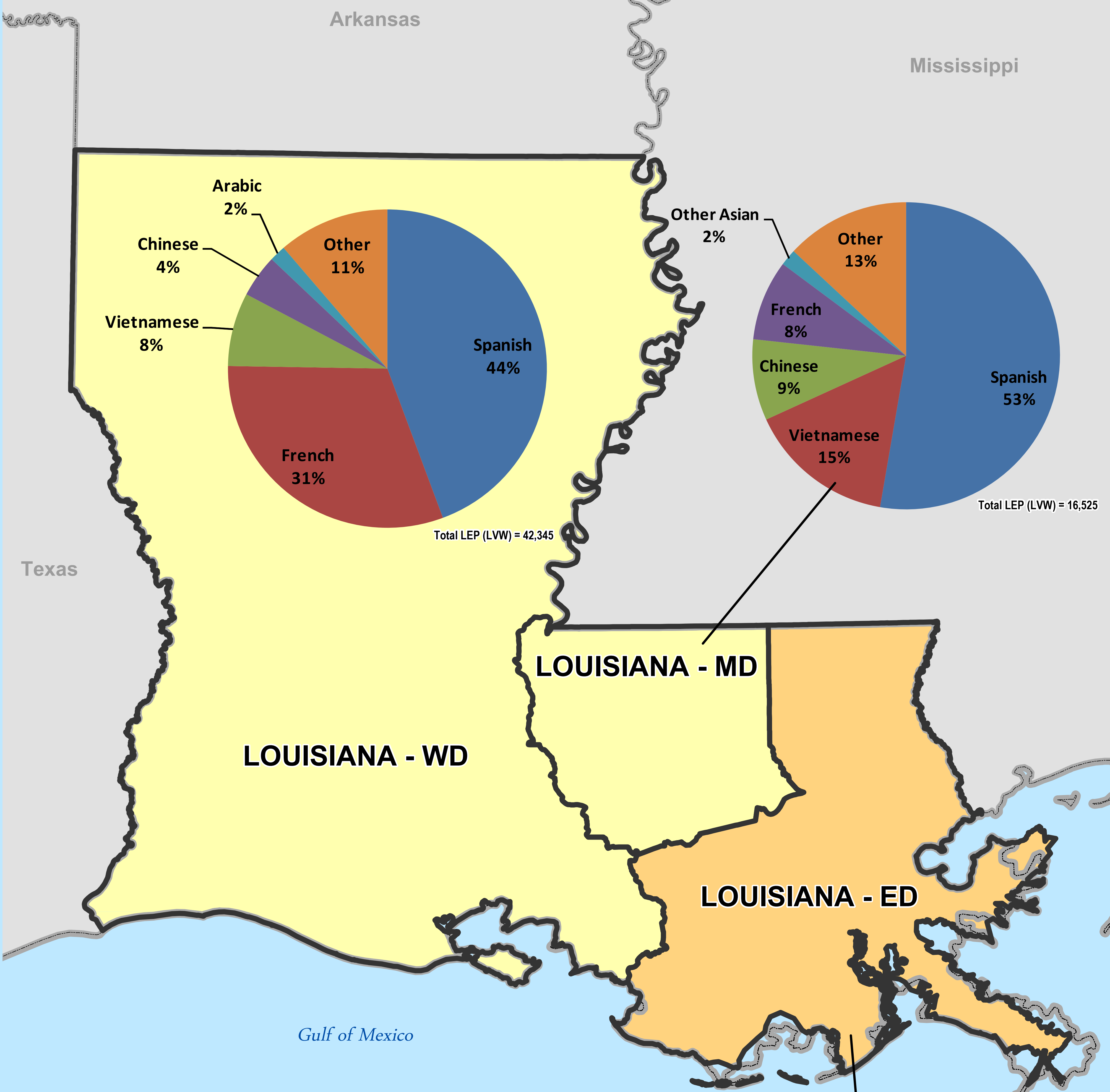
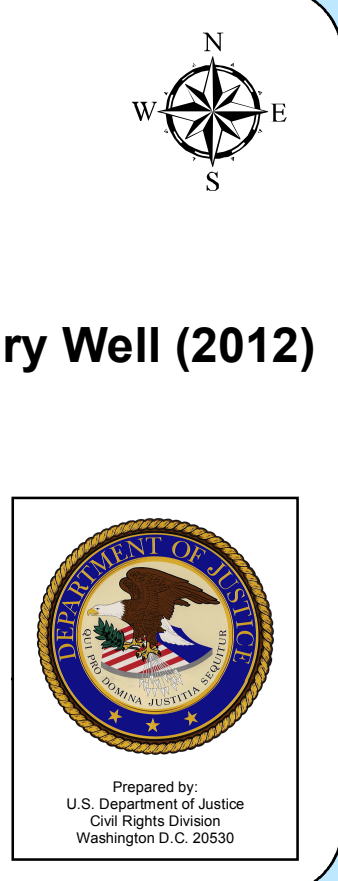


U.S. Judicial Districts - State of Louisiana (2012)
